Biopsy (Tissue Specimen for Pathologist Evaluation)
Blood Smear, peripheral, physician interpretation, report
Bone marrow aspirate smear, interpretation
Bone marrow; tephine biopsy
Cell count, misc body fluids, except blood
Cell count, misc body fluids, except blood, with differential count
Consultation, comprehensive
Consultation Report on referred slides
Consultation requiring slide preparation
Crystal ID by light microscopy w/ or w/out polarizing lens analysis, any body fluid, except urine
Cytopathology, selective cellular enhancement technique with interpretation
Cytopathology, smears, any other source; preparation, screening and interpretation
Cytopathology, smears, any other source; screening and interpretation
Decalcification
Flow Cytometry, interpretation; 2 to 8 markers
Flow Cytometry, interpretation; 9 to 15 markers
Flow Cytometry, interpretation; 16 or more markers
Gross only examination of specimen
Immunofluorescent study, each antibody; indirect method (FISH: Her2 & Urovision)
Immunohistochemical Stains
Immunohistochemistry quantitative or semiquantitative
intraoperative evaluation for specimen adequacy for breast , salivary gland and thyroid FNAs
Level I - Surgical pathology, gross examination only
Level II - Surgical pathology, gross and microscopic examination
Level III - Surgical pathology, gross and microscopic examination
Level IV - Surgical pathology, gross and microscopic examination
Level V - Surgical pathology, gross and microscopic examination
Level VI - Surgical pathology, gross and microscopic examination
Morphometric Analysis insitu hybridization
Morphometric analysis, tumor immunohistochemistry (eg, Her-2/neu, estrogen receptor/ progesterone receptor), quantitative or semiquantitative, each antibody; manual
Nasal smear for eosinophils
Pathology consultation during surgery; cytologic examination
Pathology consultation during surgery; cytologic examination, each additional site
preparation of slides, screening & interpretation if>5 slides
Special stain category 1 (Ex: AFB, GMS...)
Special stain category 2 (Ex: Iron, Trichrome ...)
